TOPIC: What you should know about genetic testing in 2018

Patricia Ward, M.S., is a Certified Genetic Counselor and Associate Professor, Baylor College of Medicine. Pat received her undergraduate degree in Zoology from Connecticut College. After working in a research laboratory for four years, she discovered the new profession of Genetic Counseling and was fortunate to be accepted in the graduate program at the University of California, Berkeley where she completed her master's degree. She has clinical experience in prenatal, pediatric and cancer genetics but has spent the largest part of her career working as a laboratory genetic counselor at Baylor. Her early publications documented in the use of new evolving molecular testing techniques which improved the care provided to patients with genetic disease and their families. More recent publications illustrate the significant impact of use of large-scale genomic testing platforms which have ended the diagnostic odyssey for many more families. Throughout her career she has maintained interest in the psychosocial aspects of genetic testing arguing that patient education and counseling are key elements in decision-making about testing and personal comprehension of the significance of test results.



YOUR TPG LOGIN AND PASSWORD


Sometimes, if you've upgraded your computer, or made changes, you will lose your automatic login for our website.

If this happens, you can click on "Forgot my user name/ password" on the login screen. You enter your email address and the ClubExpress system will send you an email with your user name and a temporary password.

After you log in, you can change this password to something more memorable (but write it down anyway!) If you click the box "Save on this computer" below the login information, your automatic login should now work.

If you'd like to update your password occasionally (recommended), you can also go to "Profile" at the top right of the page and select "User Name/Password" from the Website section (second column) on the page. The site will fill in your User Name. There will be suggestions to help create a strong password.




